

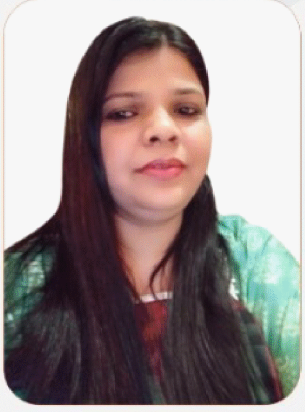

## Current Affairs Related to 4th March 2025

- ◆ **The Cayley Fund has been launched** at the restarted session of the COP16 conference held in Rome to help finance biodiversity conservation. The fund will collect contributions from businesses that use digital sequence information. These businesses include businesses such as pharmaceuticals, cosmetics, agriculture and biotechnology. The fund will support conservation efforts, and assist developing countries with biodiversity action plans. The fund will also advance scientific research on genetic data management.
- ◆ **The Central government opposed a petition seeking a lifetime ban on convicted MPs from contesting elections.** The government said such disqualifications fall exclusively within the purview of Parliament. The Centre stressed that courts cannot challenge legislative decisions on the basis of their effectiveness. The government argued that the penalty imposed on convicted MPs should be proportionate. Currently, a member of a state assembly or Parliament is disqualified from contesting elections for a period of six years on conviction for at least two years.
- ◆ **Defence Research and Development Organisation and Indian Navy successfully** flight tested the first of its kind Naval Anti Ship Missile from Integrated Test Range Chandipur. The trials demonstrated the missile's capability against ship targets launched from Indian Navy's Seaking helicopters. The trials have proved the missile's Man in the Loop feature and achieved a direct hit on a small ship target in Sea Skimming mode at its maximum range. The missile uses an indigenous Imaging Infra Red Seeker for terminal guidance.
- ◆ **Animal Welfare Board of India organised Praani Mitra and Jeev Daya Awards ceremony at Vigyan Bhavan** New Delhi. The award ceremony honours outstanding individuals and organisations who have made significant contributions to animal welfare and conservation. AWBI presented awards under two major categories Praani Mitra Awards and Jeev Daya Awards. Praani Mitra Awards were presented in five sub categories namely Defence, Innovative Ideas, Lifetime Animal Service, as well as two awards each for Animal Welfare Organisations and Corporate Public Sector Undertakings, Government bodies or Cooperative Societies.
- ◆ **The US has announced a new Gold Card investor visa program for wealthy immigrants.** The new program will replace the existing EB5 visa. Immigration Gold Cards can be purchased by companies by paying \$5 million for highly talented employees. US President Donald Trump has called this initiative an upgrade from the Green Card privileges and Green Card system. EB5 provides immigration privileges to people who invest between \$800,000 and \$1.05 million. The new program is expected to start in two weeks.
- ◆ **Department of Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade and Paytm signed MoU.** The MoU has been signed to accelerate the growth of manufacturing and fintech and fintech startups in India and promote innovation. The partnership aims to support fintech hardware startups through mentorship and innovation guidance. This will help them develop and scale payment and financial technology solutions.
- ◆ **The Green Transition Alliance India initiative has been launched by Denmark to strengthen cooperation** with India on sustainable energy solutions. It will help in the commitment to achieve global carbon neutrality. This new alliance will play a key role in promoting sustainable energy development in India, creating an ecosystem that will foster collaboration between businesses, government bodies, research institutions and financial stakeholders of the two countries. Several Danish companies including Grundfos, Copenhagen Infrastructure Partners, Sither, Novonesys and MASH Max are joining GTAI as members.
- ◆ **The Indian Army is planning to procure 223 Automatic Chemical Agent Detection and Alarm Systems** at a cost of Rs 80.43 crore under the Procurement of India category. It will boost India's self-reliance drive as more than 80% of the components and sub-systems of the equipment will be locally sourced. ACADA has been designed and developed by DRDO's Defence Research and Development Establishment, Gwalior. ACADA will enhance the Indian Army's defensive CBRN capability for operations.
- ◆ **The United Nations Security Council adopted a US-drafted resolution** on the third anniversary of Russia's invasion of Ukraine.

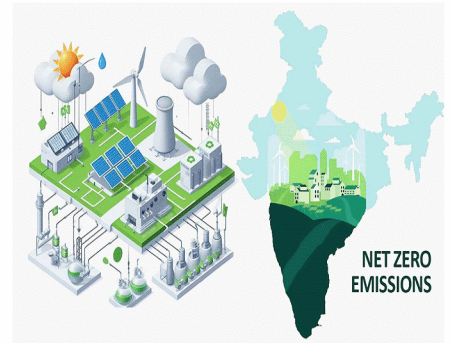
