

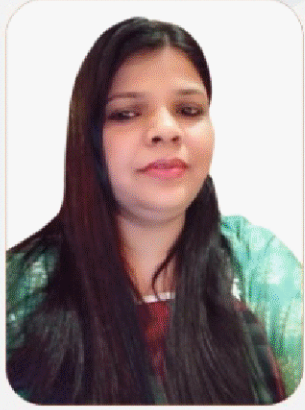

Current Affairs Related to 7th April 2025

- ◆ **India participated in the 12-day exercise organized by the Hellenic Air Force of Greece.** It is a multi-national exercise in which 15 countries are participating and it will continue till 11 April 2025. Indian Air Force contingent including AN.30 DG fighter aircraft, PS.78 and B.17 aircraft are participating in this exercise. This exercise will enhance international cooperation and interoperability among the participating air forces. The participation of the Indian Air Force is important as it will strengthen India's strategic partnerships.
- ◆ **The Telangana government has launched a scheme to provide fine rice free of cost through ration shops.** The initiative was officially launched by Chief Minister A.Revanth Reddy during the Ugadi festival at Huzurnagar in Suryapet district. The scheme aims to guarantee food security with dignity. It is the first program of its kind in India. This is India's first scheme to provide fine rice free of cost. Under this scheme, eligible ration card holders will get 6 kg of fine rice free of cost per person every month. About three crore people will benefit from this scheme.
- ◆ **Billionaire Elon Musk-led SpaceX achieved a historic milestone for commercial space flight with the launch of the unique FRAME-2 mission.** This mission will orbit the Earth from one pole to the other and four private astronauts have been sent to a place where no one has gone before. The FRAME-2 mission was launched by a Falcon 9 rocket and carried four astronauts to polar orbit for the first time using SpaceX's Crew Dragon capsule Resilience.
- ◆ **In a major administrative reshuffle in Uttar Pradesh, 582 judicial officers including 443 judges have been transferred.** Those transferred also include some additional district and sessions judges, civil judges and civil judges. The maximum transfers have been made from Kanpur, followed by Aligarh and Bareilly. Under Article 235 of the Indian Constitution, administrative control over the district and subordinate judiciary in the states lies with the respective High Court.
- ◆ **Operation Brahma was launched by India after the 7.7 magnitude earthquake in Myanmar.**
- ◆ **The Andhra Pradesh government has announced to honour renowned historian and archaeologist Maina Swamy with the prestigious medical award for his outstanding contribution in historical research and social service.** The award was proposed by Chief Minister N Chandrababu Naidu at a special function on Vijay Diwas. The Obadi Award is a prestigious honour given by the Andhra Pradesh government to people with exceptional contributions in various fields.
- ◆ **The Pakistan government has ordered law enforcement agencies to arrest and deport thousands of refugees as the government's deadline for Afghan citizenship card holders to leave the country expired.** The government instructions said that Afghans holding registration certificate cards and living in the twin cities must leave Pakistan as per the government policy. Millions of Afghans have come to Pakistan to seek refuge since the Soviet Union invaded Afghanistan in 1979.
- ◆ **The 4th Tiger Triumph exercise between India and the US, which is a tri-service humanitarian assistance and disaster relief exercise, will be held on the eastern seaboard from 1 April to 13 April 2025.** The main objective of this exercise is to promote interoperability between the armies of the two countries, develop a joint crisis response process and establish a joint coordination center, so that a better balance can be established between the Indian and US joint task forces in disaster.
- ◆ **The Strengthening Multimodal and Integrated Logistics Ecosystem program funded by the Asian Development Bank has been launched with the aim of strengthening the logistics environment in India, reducing logistics costs and student promotion.** It supports the National Logistics Policy and Speed ??Power National Master Plan, promoting multimodal logistics, standardization of warehousing and digitization of trade logistics
- ◆ **Union Home Minister Amit Shah inaugurated college development and student education worth more than Rs 800 crore in Bihar.** Many prominent personalities including Bihar Chief Minister Nitish Kumar, Chaturth Samrat Chaudhary and Vijay Kumar Sinha were present at the event.

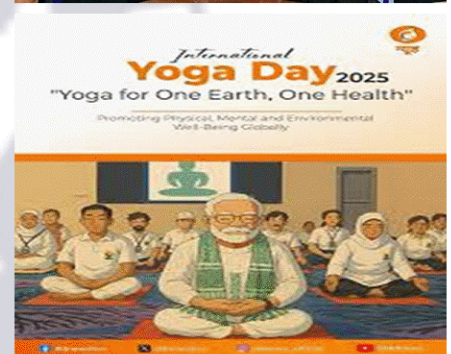
